Ryan Jesenik (Orion180) named Young Professional of the Year by the Melbourne Regional Chamber, which is given to a young professional who, through their dedication to the MRC and broader community, has made a significant impact on the Space Coast community.

The City of Palm Bay (Joan Junkala-Brown) received the International Accreditation Services' (IAS) Building Department Recognition, becoming the first in the U.S. to attain the award. IAS' accreditation programs recognize Building Departments that have been found to be in conformance with IAS Recognition Criteria, code enforcement departments and third parties providing building and/or property maintenance code enforcement services.

Florida Power and Light Company (Bart Gaetjens) was ranked #1 in residential service among large electric utilities in the southern U.S. by the J.D. Power 2021 Electric Utility Residential Customer Satisfaction Study. FPL received the highest ranking in the 2021 study for power quality and reliability, price, billing and payment, corporate citizenship, and communications. This marks the second year in a row and the third time FPL has achieved the residential top ranking in its region along with the first year FPL has achieved the business ranking in the South.

The Melbourne Orlando International Airport (Mark Busalacchi and Jack Ryals) received the 2021 Corporate Impact Award at the Melbourne Regional Chamber's Impact Awards and Board Installation event. The Impact Awards recognize individuals and organizations who have profoundly impacted the Space Coast community.

The Viera Company (Todd Pokrywa) Viera ranked #13 in the US on Real Estate Consulting's (RCLCO) The Top-Selling Master-Planned Communities of 2021 list. The city jumped three spots from its 2020 ranking of #16, with Viera's home sales seeing another year of increase.

The City of Cocoa (Hon. Lorraine Koss) received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA). One of the highest forms of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, Cocoa received the award for its FY 2020 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).

Keiser University (Colleen Browne) ranked #5 among colleges and universities in the country in providing social mobility to its students in the U.S. News and World Report's 2022 Best Colleges ranking. Keiser was the #1 rated university in Florida for the category.
